Memphis School of Excellence (MSE) is a public charter school serving 600 students in grades K through 12. MSE has been serving its community since the 2010-2011 school year.

#### Our Staff and Students

Our staff is committed to excellence as they work to prepare our students to achieve their future educational and career goals. 100% of our courses are taught by teachers who are certified and highly qualified in the subject area. Our teachers have earned the highest scores from the state over the last 3 years.

#### The Curriculum

MSE follows the state curriculum. MSE offers extra periods for math, science, and English classes. MSE regularly tests students to see progress. MSE provides after school tutoring, pull out tutoring, Saturday tutoring, and evening tutoring. MSE does not offer summer school. MSE offers several honors courses for all high school students. Honor classes are weighted 4.5 credits on students' GPA. MSE offered 5 AP classes and plans to increase the number of AP classes every year. AP students will earn 5 credits.

#### Extracurricular Activities

MSE offers several after school clubs and activities. More than 60% of the students participate in the after school programs.

## Graduation Rate

MSE has 100% graduation rates for 2014, 2015 and 2016, and 98% in 2017.

## ACT Score

MSE's ACT score has gone up at least a point every year. MSE's average score was 13.8 in 2014 and rose to 15.8 in 2015, and rose to 16.9 in 2016 and 18.8 in 2017. MSE had several students score over a 24 in 2016.

## College Readiness

100% of our students are accepted to a 4 year college. The class of 2017 raised more than \$4 million in scholarships. The majority of our graduated students participated in the TN Promise program.
